In order to enhance the relationship between Taiwanese American and the community where Taiwanese American lives and to provide encouragement and inspiration of young Americans to excel in leadership, community services as well as academic achievement, the Taiwan Culture Center (TCC) of the greater Washington area is proud to sponsor the Taiwanese American Community Scholarship Award (TACSA) for 2018. TCC Board of Directors (BOD) would like to invite all qualified senior students to apply for this scholarship before the deadline, **April 17, 2018**.

ELIGIBILITY

The program is open to all U.S. citizens or permanent residents who are **college-bound high school graduating seniors** from the Washington metropolitan D.C. area. In addition to Washington D.C., the following counties are considered to be in the Washington D.C. metropolitan area:

- Montgomery County, Maryland
- Howard County, Maryland
- Prince George County, Maryland
- Frederick County, Maryland
- Fairfax County, Virginia
- Arlington County, Virginia
- Alexandria County, Virginia
- Loudon County, Virginia
- Prince Williams County, Virginia

The Taiwanese American Community Scholarship Award is **open to all qualified students from all ethnic groups**.

APPLICATION PROCESS

To be considered, the following items must be submitted for review:

1. A copy of the application form (preferably online at <http://TaiwanCultureCtr.org/tacsa/>)
2. One recommendation letter in a sealed envelope from the applicant's guidance counselor or teacher
3. One official high school transcript
4. A written essay of no more than 500 words on **"My Most Rewarding Experience of Participation in Community Services."**
5. A brief biography of no more than 250 words will be used to introduce you at the award ceremony.
6. A photo of yourself in JPEG not larger than 2 inches by 2 inches, to be included in the award ceremony program.
7. A photocopy of your highest SAT/ACT score from the College Board.
8. Resume including extra curricula activities and a list of community activities and Services that the applicant had participated including the duration and frequency.
